

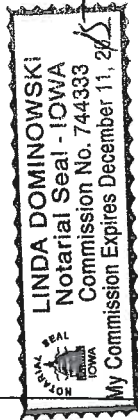

PUBLIC NOTICE OF STORM WATER DISCHARGE

AGP Sergeant Bluff plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the NPDES General Permit #2, "Storm Water Discharge associated with industrial activity for construction activities."

The storm water discharge will be from construction activities located in Section 31, T87N, R47W, Woodbury County. Storm water will be discharged from one (1) point source(s) and will be discharged to the following streams: Missouri River.
