This letter is follow up to the IDNR letter of February 21, 2002 that directed you to conduct further assessment of two petroleum spills at the IOCO facility located a 100 First Street, Dubuque, Iowa (Spill #01238-KL-2128) and (Spill #02038-SD-1140). At this time the IDNR is re-evaluating the need for further assessment or remedial action; however, in order to grant that deferral current ground water data is required.

According to the project file the IDNR approved a work plan in an April 30, 2002 letter for (soil and ground water) assessment submitted on behalf of the IOCO facility by Seneca Environmental Services. To date the IDNR has not received the results of that assessment, providing it was actually conducted. Please inform the IDNR if the assessment has been conducted, and if so please forward a copy of the assessment report to the IDNR for review and approval. In addition to the results of the aforementioned assessment current ground water monitoring data are required. Additional ground water samples will not be necessary if they were collected as part of the required assessment. Please contact me you (or have your designated environmental contractor) at the address below if you have any questions, or to discuss re-sampling the existing monitoring wells at the IOCO facility for petroleum hydrocarbons.
