
This information is submitted on behalf of Mr. Merlin Hove, Director, City of Ames Municipal Electric Administration.

Attached find a copy of a summary report regarding Limited Assessment Activities at a former lumber stockyard located in Ames, Iowa. A Phase I Preacquisition Site Assessment (PSA) for the referenced site demonstrated a historic use of the site for two (2) bulk fuel storage businesses. Subsequent soil and water testing indicates the presence of petroleum impact at both bulk fuel storage site on the parcel.
