

On September 11, 2000, I attended a pre - construction Meeting regarding the final remedial actions at this site. The following plans were made during the meeting:

- 1. Alter Trading will remove their interior rail lines as needed.
- 2. General Excavating will cap the culvert that drains to the pond; see attached diagram.
- 3. General Excavating will begin earth work on September 20, 2000, if weather allows.
- 4. The area west of the pond will be developed into a concrete parking lot; there will be no liner. On top of the contaminated soil will be a 6" layer of stone which will be topped with a 10" layer of concrete.
- 5. The soils east of the pond will be capped with a geosynthetic liner (to include a drainage net) and then covered with 18" of topsoil.
- 6. There was some question as to how surface water drainage will be handled. Curt Hartog plans to address that at a later date.
- 7. General Excavating is planning to bury some pieces of broken concrete further east of the capped area. I reminded them that, while concrete is rubble and may be buried, solid waste from the site may not be buried or permanently disposed of on site and must be hauled to a sanitary landfill.
- 8. An easement or deed restriction still needs to be developed for maintenance of the capped area and the parking lot.
