Subject: Morton Custom Plastics – No Further Action Letter

Dear Mr. Oxer:

This letter replaces our letter dated March 29, 2004. The Iowa Department of Natural Resources has reviewed the monitoring report submitted to the department on March 23, 2004 as well as previous data on remediation activities at the Innovative Injection Technologies (former Morton Custom Plastics) facility situated at 2360 Grand Avenue, West Des Moines, Iowa. The latest groundwater monitoring report indicated TEH-diesel concentration as non-detect in all the monitoring wells sampled on February 9 & 20, 2004. These results were similar to those observed in samples taken on August 19, 2003. Therefore, the department will not require any additional investigation or remediation as a result of the activities associated with current contaminants. However, the department reserves the right to require additional investigation/remediation if future information, not identified in the reports, suggests such an action is warranted.

Please ensure that all borings and monitoring wells are plugged and abandoned according to Iowa Administrative Code 567—Chapter 39. You may contact the IDNR Water Supply Section (Brent Parker at 515-725-0337) for additional information concerning this requirement.
