Subject: Former Foulke Rubber Products Site – Pella


Dear Mr. Vos:

This letter is to inform you that the Iowa Department of Natural Resources no longer requires any further monitoring at the former Foulke Rubber Products site (now Pella Swine Services) situated at 916 w. 8th Street, Pella, Iowa. Our decision is based on the sampling results in the past two years which show contaminant levels of concern have declined to levels below Iowa statewide standards as provided in Iowa Administrative Code Chapters 133 and 137. No further action is required on the site. However, this no-further-action letter does not prevent the department from requiring additional investigation if current contaminants are implicated in future hazardous condition at the site.

The monitoring wells should be properly plugged and abandoned. Forward copies of the plugging record to the department.
