Dear Mr. Moore:

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Contaminated Sites Section, (Department) has been monitoring environmental assessment/remedial activities at the above referenced site currently owned by Diamond V Mills. During the environmental assessment it was determined that operations at the former Ronald Moore Oil Company site were the most likely cause of petroleum contamination in the soil and groundwater. Therefore, as per the Iowa Administrative Code IAC-567-133, Rules for Determining Cleanup Actions and Responsible Parties, the Ronald Moore Oil Company shall complete a site assessment plan as describe in 133.2. The site assessment plan shall be submitted to the Department within 45 days of receiving this letter.

Diamond V Mills has completed various environmental assessment activities at the site and their reports and findings are available in the Department's record center for your review. The Department's record center is on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor of the Wallace State Office Building at 502 East 9<sup>th</sup> Street in Des Moines with the information located in file CON: 12-15 Diamond V Mills, Cedar Rapids, Iowa.
