Dear Mr. Flynn

This letter is to provide you with a copy of the public notice that appeared on June 2nd 2004 in the Valley News Today in Shenandoah, Iowa.

The purpose of the notice was to inform the general public of Shenandoah of the environmental assessment and clean up activities that were conducted from 1995 through 2004 on property located at 912 6th Avenue which is owned by MidAmerican Energy.

It has been determined through the assessment and clean up actions that contaminated ground water from the MidAmerican property (912 6th Ave.) has migrated under your property. There is no known risk to your health from this ground water condition. A local ordinance (referenced in the notice) restricting the use of ground water from a private well as long as the city can provide safe drinking water (from another source) to the affected properties under which the contamination is located. The city of Shenandoah is currently and will continue to provide you with drinking water.

The IDNR is also required under rules of the Land Recycling Program to inform you (as a protected party) that you assume no liability for the contamination and that upon request you are eligible for a No Further Action letter.
