This letter is to inform you that the IDNR has reviewed the soil sampling data for the proposed playground at the Kaboom child care facility located at 1216 E. 25th Street in Des Moines, Iowa. The IDNR understands that the play area will be unpaved with a bed of mulch for cushioning.

The results of the soil analyses indicate they are acceptable with respect to the statewide standard for lead, and although the soil detections for arsenic exceed the standard of 1.9 PPM, the concentrations are within the range for natural concentrations for arsenic found in Iowa soil. As such, the soil conditions are not considered to constitute a hazardous condition.
