

I have received the Tier 2 report for the above referenced site. It recommends annual monitoring of well 1, 2 and 6. I approve this plan. These wells should give us indications of changes at the site; however, the department reserves the right to include more wells if it deems that conditions warrant the increase.

Since the wells were last monitored in 1999, it is expected that the first annual post-RBCA report is due this year. I will expect the report by August 31, 2000. Please let me know within 15 days if this presents any insurmountable problems.
