All three sites will be coded into CERCLIS with the NFRAP (No Further Remedial Action Planned) designation.

DISCUSSION/RATIONALE: Based information contained in the Preliminary Assessment/ Site Inspection completed by the EPA (dated December 29, 1998) this site does not appear to pose a significant threat to human health or the environment. A removal was completed at this site in on 6/26/97 which removed containerized waste and contaminated soil. At this time no significant risk to any of the pathways is suspected. This site will be given an "N" qualifier representing the NFRAP designation. If new information becomes available or site conditions change this site could be reopened.
