The Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Contaminated Sites Section (Department), has completed the review of the above referenced report submitted by Environmental Strategies Consulting LLC for the Magellan Pipeline Company (Magellan).

After reviewing the current data, along with previously submitted data, the Department has determined that no further environmental action is required at this time for this monitoring activity. Although the site requires no further action, the Department reserves the right to require additional work at the site if conditions change. This decision is based on information supplied by Magellan. All temporary-monitoring wells placed to monitor this environmental action can be removed at this time if they are not required for any other propose. Please follow Department rules when abandoning the monitoring wells.

It is understood that Magellan will leave the perimeter monitoring wells in place as part of Magellan's monitoring program.
