NOTICE OF CORRECTION

APPENDIX A

Site Description

The Winnebago Drum Site is located west of Highway 69 on the property of Winnebago Industries, Inc. The land on which the site is located is described in the Deed Record, Winnebago County, as follows:

That portion of B. Johanson's Subdivision of the East Sixty (60) acres of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Township 98 North, Range 24 West of the 5th P.M. described as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Southwest Quarter; the Easterly line of 00⁰59'46" E 1599.50 feet along Southwest Quarter to the point of beginning; thence continuing S 00°59'46" E 1074.50 feet along said easterly line of the Southwest Quarter to the Southeast corner of said Southwest Quarter: thence S 890 13'04" W 990.00 feet along the Southerly line of said Southwest Quarter to the Westerly line of said B. East 60 acres; thence N Johanson's Subdivision of the $00^{\circ}59'46"$ W 811.59 feet along said Westerly line of B. Johanson's Subdivision to the beginning of a tangent curve of 260.00 foot radius concave Southeasterly; thence Northeasterly 408.70 feet through a central angle of 9003'54" to a point of tangency; thence N 89°4'08" E 729.71 feet along a line parallel with the Northerly line of said Southwest Quarter to the point of beginning; containing 24.06 acres.
