Dear Lambert and Bob:

I spoke with Dave Wornson about the above property and Lambert's e-mail of November 29, 2007, to me and Steve Jessee. Dave advised me that Lambert is out of the country and suggested that I send this e-mail to both of you. As you recall, as part of the closure process Aramark agreed to an Environmental Covenant on the premises which, by its terms, prohibits any new water wells. The Covenant was filed with the Polk County Recorder on September 13, 2006. Dave Wornson confirmed that this Covenant is in your file. After discussing the matter with Dave and looking at the Covenant, it appears that the Covenant should suffice as an institutional control and that no further certification letter should be required. I understand from Dave that Polk County has a 2E Agreement with the City of Des Moines and that pursuant to a Polk County Ordinance, no further water wells can be placed on a property if public water is available at that same site. This ordinance would act as a further institutional control by its very existence.

I would appreciate it if you could take another look at this file and see if the no further action certificate could be issued at this time. As you recall, this site is very similar to the Sioux City site which also had an Environmental Covenant put in place by Aramark and which was closed. I believe you, Bob, handled that file.
