

Submitted on behalf of Shell Oil Company (Shell), Equiva Services, LLC (Equiva) has prepared this environmental protection easement in response to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) letter dated July 24, 2001. Upon your approval, Shell will submit the easement to the Office of the Recorder or the Registrar of Titles of Scott County within 45 days of receipt. The easement will be recorded in accordance with Iowa law so that it forms a permanent part of the chain of title for the site to ensure current and future users of the property will be informed of the conditions of the institutional control placed on the property. Within 30 days of being recorded, a certified copy of the letter, as recorded, will be forwarded to the IDNR.
