IMI Cornelius Inc. 2421 15th Street SW Mason City, Cerro Gordo County, lowa
The Iowa Department of Natural Re-

sources (DNR) is proposing to issue a No Further Action (NFA) certificate under the lowa Land Recycling Program (LRP) to IMI Cornelius Inc. for the property at 2421 15th Street SW, Mason City, Iowa. Construction began on the original manufacturing building in October 1973 and operations began in October 1974 for Schneider Metal Manufacturing. The facility was later sold IMI Cornelius who is the current owner. The IMI Cornelius former operations included the manufacturing of beverage dispensing systems and ice makers for the food service industry. Finished goods were stored inside the warehouse. Raw materials consisting of various sheet metals, cold rolled steel and copper were punched, sheared and formed into necessary parts. Hazardous materials storage/ use during facility operations primarily consist of lubricating oils, isopropyl alcohol, solder, cleaners, adhesives, non-CFC foam, and paint.

The previous owner reportedly use a vapor degreaser with the chlorinated solvent 1,1,1-trichoroethylene. Low levels of VOC were confirmed to be solvent 1,1,1-trichoroetnylene. Low levels of VOC were confirmed to be present in the shallow groundwater along a relatively narrow plume originating under the facility. Of the VOC present, only 1,1-dichloroethene exceeds the lowa statewide standard for a protected groundwater source of 7.0 ug/L. The concentrations of 1,1-dichloroethene in MW-5, MW-3 and MW-7 are in the range of 7 to 12 ug/L and this pattern indicates that there is no nearby source of elevated 1,1-dichloroethene concentrations in the soil or groundwater, and suggests an historic source that no longer exists (the former degreaser). The soil pathway at the site has been evaluated and found not to pose significant human health risks for the existing and planned future land use as no soil sample exceeded the State-

isting and planned future land use as no soil sample exceeded the State-wide Soil Standards. Groundwater contamination above the statewide standards (equivalent to drinking water standards) exists at the site. The area of contaminated groundwater is stable or decreasing. It is expected contaminant concentrations will remain stable or continue to decrease a result of natural attenuation proas a result of natural attenuation pro-cesses. Risks associated with potential exposure to contaminated ground-water will be prevented by ensuring impacted groundwater at the site will not be used. An environmental cove-nant will prohibit the installation of wa-ter wells on the property.
