Dear Mr. Loecke,

This letter is to inform you that the IDNR has received and reviewed the Site Monitoring Report (3rd Quarter 2009) for the Three Rivers FS Company site facility located at 305 North Central Avenue in Epworth, Iowa. The IDNR notes results of this monitoring report are consistent with previous ground water data indicating the presence of nitrate contaminated ground water in excess of state standards in monitoring wells #2 and #3.

Due to the detection of nitrate in these two monitoring wells in excess of the state standard, the IDNR directs you to conduct annual monitoring from monitoring wells #2 and #3 for 2010 and 2011 and to submit (annual) reports to the IDNR Contaminated Sites Section for review and approval. Upon receipt of the 2011 monitoring report the IDNR will determine if further monitoring is required. At this time monitoring from wells #1, #4 and #5 may be terminated and must be properly abandoned.
