The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency received a letter dated June 29, 2012, from the URS Corporation on behalf of United Technologies Corporation (UTC). The letter contained a June 18, 2012, post-remedial action inspection form and photographs for the Sheller-Globe Corporation Disposal site located near Keokuk, Iowa. Based upon this information, the site conditions appear to be satisfactory at this time. The EPA thanks UTC for their continued efforts at the Sheller-Globe Corporation Disposal site.

As you are aware, the information obtained during these inspections is necessary to permit the EPA to conduct the five-year reviews required by Section 121 (c) of CERCLA as described in Section VII, Paragraph 16 of the Consent Decree. As indicated in the June 2010 Second Five-Year Review Report, the next post-remedial action inspection is scheduled for Spring 2014.
