Dear Mr. Lincoln

This letter is to inform you that the IDNR has received the Groundwater Sampling Report for the Lincoln Farm & Home Service facility located at Lot 5 Railroad Addition Blk1, Henderson, IA.

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has reviewed this report and the overall site history. As a result of that review it is the determination of the IDNR that this report, coupled with the years of monitoring, has demonstrated the limited extent and stability of the groundwater contamination plume and the declining concentration of contamination. As a result of the demonstrated conditions, the IDNR will allow the request to terminate monitoring. Please note that the DNR does not consider the site to be free from contamination but no longer requires monitoring.

This site has been managed by DNR Contaminated Sites Section under the authority of Chapter 133. As such, this letter allows for the termination of monitoring but does not constitute a No Further Action letter. Site closure through a No Further Action Letter or Certificate of Closure may only be received by enrolling the site in the Land Recycling program (LRP). Therefore, in the event that a future spill occurs and/or sampling demonstrates a level of contamination greater than currently documented, or if the DNR determines the site presents a threat to the environment in the future, the DNR may reopen the site and require additional monitoring or remediation.

As a result of termination of monitoring, monitoring wells scheduled for abandonment should be closed following proper abandonment procedures and a notice of monitoring well closure submitted to the DNR on the appropriate DNR form 542-1226.
