NOTICE OF HAZARDOUS WASTE SITE REGISTRY CLOSURE


On or about May 28, 1992, the director of the Department of Natural Resources provided notice that the real property then owned by Rodney Grap and Jennifer Grap, known as the Glenwood Dump, was placed on the registry of hazardous waste or hazardous substance disposal sites. A "Notice of Intent" was recorded in the Mills County Records office at book 190, page 575 on August 17, 1992. The current owner of the property is Jimmy L. King, P.O. Box 5, Willow, OK, 73673. The subject property is legally described as:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 21, T73N, R43W of the 5th P.M., Mills County, Iowa. Thence North along the east line of the said Section 21 a distance of 1250 feet to the point of beginning, on the west bank of the unnamed creek. Thence West a distance of 200 feet; North a distance of 590 feet; East a distance of 175 feet; and southeasterly/south along the west bank of the unnamed creek to the point of beginning.

The director has now determined that closure activities have been completed and that the site is now properly classified pursuant to Iowa Code section 455B.427(3) as "e - site properly closed, no evidence of present or potential adverse impact-no further action required."

Pursuant to section 455B.427(4) of the Code of Iowa the site shall be removed from all subsequent annual reports and the registry of hazardous waste or hazardous substance disposal sites. This finding does not warrant to a future purchaser of the site that the site will be free from any future adverse impacts as a result of use of the site as a hazardous waste or hazardous substances disposal site. The removal of this site is being executed in conjunction with an easement designed to implement continuing restrictions on the use of this property until such time as these restrictions are deemed to be no longer appropriate.



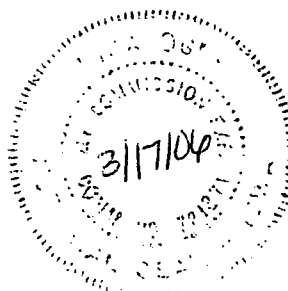
