In a January 5, 2016 letter from Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Contaminated Sites Section, (IDNR) you were given 45 days to send a revised environmental site assessment work plan for the soil and groundwater assessment at the above referenced site. As of the date of this letter IDNR has not received the revised work plan. The submitted site investigation work plan, dated December 7, 2015, had too many deficiencies to fully characterize the petroleum contamination found at the site. This action is being taken under the authority of IAC-567-133, *Rules for Determining Cleanup Actions and Responsible Parties*.
