SUBJECT: Environmental assessment for DuTrac Community Credit Union at East 14th & Elm. Dubuque

Dear Mr. Sarvis:

Staff of the IDNR Solid Waste Section have had the opportunity to review and discuss the materials submitted regarding the environmental assessment for the DuTrac Community Credit Union property at East 14th and Elm Streets in Dubuque.

The department has been inundated with varied reports of contamination, generally stemming from environmental assessments conducted for the purpose of property transfer. Because the number of such sites far exceeds the resources we have available for addressing them, we have been forced to prioritize them. We will be dealing only with sites which we deem to be the most serious threats to human health Our first priority is sites where there is an existing or imminent threat of human exposure to levels of contamination in excess of health based guidelines. A second group of sites, which we will deal with as resources are available, will include sites characterized by: very high levels of contaminants, the probability of large amounts of waste, and/or the likelihood of an ongoing release of contaminants

Recent data indicate the presence of soil and groundwater contamination, at the site in question by petroleum compounds, some of which exceeds guidelines used by this department. The investigation also indicates that this contamination is apparently of limited distribution. Therefore the IDNR will require no further action in this case. This judgment is based on information currently available to us and is subject to revision, if additional information suggests such a change to be warranted. It should be noted that many environmental assessments are cursory in nature and do not, therefore, provide adequate information to permit an evaluation with a high degree of confidence.
