The Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Contaminated Sites Section, (Iowa DNR) has reviewed the above referenced work plan prepared by the Braun Intertec Corporation on behalf of Canadian Pacific and accepts the work plan as written. Under the section describing groundwater sampling it notes the monitoring wells will be permitted with the state, this would be as described in Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) 567-38, *Private Well Construction Permits*. In IAC-38.3(2) it is noted monitoring wells required by Iowa DNR are exempt from the permitting process along with monitoring wells that will be in place for less than seven days. Also, please review IAC-567-39, *Requirements for Properly Plugging Abandoned Wells*, prior to completing the field work.
