Regarding: Public Notification of Actions to be taken in compliance with the Iowa Administrative Code IAC-567.137.7(4), and IAC-567.137.8(6) for the Land Recycling Program and Response Action Standards for the East Blum Property in Dubuque, Iowa.

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources (Iowa DNR) Contaminated Sites Section (Department) has prepared this public notice for comment prior to the final approval of a Risk Evaluation Response Action (RE/RA) and the issuance of a no further action classification (137.11(2)) for the East Blum Property.

In June 2019, all environmental site assessment activities of soil and ground water at the property were completed. Based on the results of the assessment all appropriate remedial actions to address soil contamination were completed and the associated risk to public health evaluated. NOTICE OF FILING OF DELINQUENT PROBLEM PROPERTY CHARGES IN ACCORDANCE WITH 14-111 INTERNATIONAL INTERESTER'S NUISANCE CODE SECTION 106.5 AND OR 109.5 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DUBUQUE, IOWA.**

14-111 of the Code of Ordinances provides that vacant and abandoned buildings and problem properties are considered a substandard condition that requires that such conditions be ordered to be remedied. 14-111 also provides that the City shall have the authority to correct a nuisance that is "palpably and indisputably such," without notice. 14-111 also provides that the City Clerk shall certify such cost for the abatement of situations where the nuisance is "palpably and indisputably such" to the County Treasurer and it shall then constitute a lien against said property and be collected with and in the same manner as general taxes on said properties.

As of May 31, 2019, the costs for a nuisance that are "palpably and indisputably such," such as problem property charges, shall be certified by the City Clerk to the Dubuque County Treasurer for collection with, and in the same manner as, general property taxes. The persons listed on the attached Problem Property Assessment schedule have unpaid problem property charges in the amount set out and said charges are delinquent.

The assessments may be paid in full or in part without interest at the City Treasurer's Office, City Hall, 50 W. 13th Street, Dubuque, Iowa, at any time within 30 days after the date of the first publication of the notice of the filing of the Schedule of Assessments with the County Treasurer. AF-
