Dear Mr. Goldstein:

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Contaminated Sites Section, (Iowa DNR) has reviewed the above referenced work plan submitted by KPRG and Associates, Inc. on behalf of Alter Logistics and has the following comment:

- The proposed scope of work includes collecting soil and groundwater samples that will be analyzed for total extractable hydrocarbons (TEH) diesel, TEH waste oil, and semivolatile organic hydrocarbons (SVOC). The only two sample methods needed for the work plan are Iowa OA-1 and Iowa OA-2. SVOC samples are not needed and can be removed from the work plan.

Test method Iowa OA-1 includes gasoline range compounds and is required at all potential petroleum sites during the initial investigation as noted in 567-Iowa Administrative Code-135.8(3). Test method Iowa OA-2 includes TEH diesel and TEH waste oil among others. Please include the OA-2 chromatograms supplied by the laboratory in the site investigation report.

With the inclusion of test method Iowa OA-1 in your sample plan the work plan is accepted and can be carried out as written.
