On the behalf of Lineage Logistics (Lineage), owner of 8 K Avenue Ottumwa, Iowa (the Site), Enviro-Sciences (of Delaware), Inc. (ESI) is submitting the February 2014 Phase I Environmental Site Assessment and subsequent May 2017 Limited Phase II Investigation to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) for review and determination of regulatory compliance.
