The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 7 has made the final decision to reissue the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Hazardous Waste Management Permit for the Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc., Davenport Branch on 3035 W. 73rd Street, Davenport, Iowa 52806. Enclosed are the final Permit and Response to Comments.

The EPA set a 45-day public comment period, which started on August 13, 2021, and ended on September 27, 2021. The public, including Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc, was encouraged to review and comment on the EPA's Permit, and on the other information contained in the Administrative Record. No comments were received on the Permit during the public comment period and no changes were made from the draft to the final Permit; therefore, the EPA's Permit became effective on the date it is issued, in accordance with Title 40 Code of Federal Regulation § 124.15(b)(3).

The administrative record, which contains all of the information considered by the EPA in making its decision to reissue the Permit, will be updated with additional documents including the final Permit and the Response to Comments. The administrative record will continue to be available for public review at the following locations:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has decided to issue a final Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Hazardous Waste Management Permit to the Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc., Davenport Branch, which is located at 3035 W. 73rd Street in Davenport, Iowa.

Public participation activities associated with the draft and final Permits have been conducted in accordance with 40 Code of Federal Regulations Part 124. The EPA provided a draft Permit for public comment from August 13, 2021 to September 27, 2021. A public notice was issued in the Quad-City Times newspaper, a fact sheet was mailed to the permit mailing list and expanded residence/business mailing list, and radio announcements were made on a local stations, WOC 1420 AM and WLLR 103.7 FM, announcing the availability of the draft Permit and the start of a 45-day public comment period. The Administrative Record for the EPA's draft Permit was available throughout the comment period at the Davenport Public Library and the EPA Region 7 Records Center, Lenexa, Kansas. A public hearing was not held on the draft Permit and one was not requested during the public comment period.

No comments were received on the Permit during the public comment period and no revisions were made from the draft to the final Permit; therefore, the Permit will become effective the date it is issued, in accordance with 40 CFR Part 125.15(b)(3).
