I have reviewed the Phase I and Phase II for the Jaycox site and there wasn't enough information to make any environmental determination, the biggest issue is a lack of soil sampling and no groundwater samples. You have numerous potential areas for release but no groundwater samples and only two soil samples.

If you want a closure type review more data would be needed.

The wash pad is no longer being used and will be, if it hasn't already, be abandoned.
