The Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Contaminated Sites Section, has reviewed the above referenced phase III scope of work submitted by Golder Associates Inc. on behalf of the Eaton Corporation (Eaton). The scope of work is approved as written with an understanding of the following; I completed a quick review of water wells near the Eaton facility and found, in general, a sand seam 30 to 35 feet below the land surface that continued to the bedrock around 60 feet below the surface. This indicates you might have to drill a little deeper than 30 feet as indicated in the scope of work in order to get good contact with the aquifer.
