The Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Contaminated Sites Section, has not received the required chromium remedial action work plan for the chromium contaminated soil at the Former United Hydraulics Facility in Hampton, Iowa. The remedial efforts were anticipated to be completed by the end of 2022 with the chromium VI site specific cleanup goal of 21mg/kg.

At this time, you will have until Friday June 24, 2022 to submit the chromium remedial action work plan. The work plan should also include the proposed schedule for the remedial action field work.
