I finally had a chance to look over the latest monitoring report in reference to monitoring well CM95-10 and it would need to be reinstalled as close as possible to its current location. The only additional information I would need, at the time you plan on plugging the well, is an email (or letter) briefly describing the plugging via a certified well driller and the schedule for replacing the well. It is understood the well might not get replaced until the construction is to a point where the replacement well would not be damaged by construction activities.
