Dear Mr. Rob McDonald and Mr. Jon Dienst:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed your letter dated August 11, 2022, providing advance notification of construction around A.Y. McDonald Property and request for the deviation of the Environmental Covenant on the northeast corner of A. Y. McDonalds property. Based on the review of the letter, it is EPA's understanding that the temporary deviation of the covenant is being requested on the northeast corner of the A.Y. McDonald property for the purpose of a staging area for the construction of the Bee Branch Trail. This notification was provided in accordance with activity and use limitations stipulated in Section 7b of the Environmental Covenant recorded for the property in 2018.

Within this letter, the EPA provides its consent of the proposed activities conditioned upon the following: 1) ensuring worker health and safety, 2) proper handling and management of contaminated excavated materials including any contaminated soils or groundwater, and 3) ensuring that the integrity of the engineered barriers and security fencing is maintained upon completion of excavation activities in accordance with the EPA-approved Environmental Covenant.
