The IDNR has reviewed the post soil removal groundwater monitoring report for the lowa Northern Railway site in Waterloo, Iowa. Soil excavation completed in 2017 removed approximately 704 tons of contaminated soil from the site. The monitoring wells that remain on-site after the soil removal include MW-6, MW-7, MW-9, MW-11, and MW-12. The monitoring report recommends sampling these remaining wells annually for the next two years to determine stable/declining concentrations of petroleum contaminants using Methods OA-1 and OA-2. The IDNR concurs with the recommendation for annual groundwater sampling. Keep in mind that the results will determine the duration of the monitoring required to establish a stable/decreasing trend.
