Dear Mr. Barkalow;

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Contaminated Sites Section, (Iowa DNR) has reviewed the above referenced soil management plan submitted by Stanley Consulting Inc. on behalf of the City of Marion, Iowa and has no comments. The soil management plan is accepted as written with acknowledgment of the following:

- Within 45 days of completing the removal of the soil pile a final report will need be submitted to the Iowa DNR documenting/describing the removal activities including the final confirmation sampling locations, final location for the removed soil, analytical results for the field samples and laboratory samples, and a copy of the landfill receipts for the soil transported to the landfill. If possible, a few photographs would be a helpful addition to the final report.

As noted in the soil management plan, the soil that passes testing and available for unrestricted use will be reused at non-residential sites. This is not a requirement of Iowa DNR but an appreciated action to help prevent perceived contaminated soil issues. Please let me know when the field work has been scheduled so I may have the opportunity to be on site.
