**DISCUSSION/RATIONALE FOR ARCHIVAL:**

See the attached Decision Document not to Cost Recover and the CERCLIS printout for the site.

The Fort Dodge Containers Site is located at 806-812 1st Avenue South, Fort Dodge, Iowa. The City of Fort Dodge, Iowa, was in the process of demolishing the building at this location when a number of containers of chemicals were discovered. The building had been vacant for approximately 20 years. It was originally a restaurant on the main floor and apartments on the second and third floors. The Fort Dodge Fire Department requested assistance thru the State of Iowa for clean up and disposal.

The EPA responded to the scene on May 21, 2001. The EPA conducted a removal action which consisted of assisting the Fire Department in HazCatting the chemicals, segregating and overpacking the materials and placing them in temporary storage. There were a total of 23 drums that were disposed of at the ONYX Environmental Services, Menomonee Falls, WI. The removal action was completed on July 24, 2001.

All removal activities have been completed. No known monitoring wells were installed under the authority of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act/Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (CERCLA/SARA). No further response under CERCLA/SARA is required and archiving is appropriate.
