Contaminated Sites Database Site ID No. 105 Free Product Recovery Report, 2<sup>nd</sup> Half of 2024

Dear Ms. Tittjung:

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR), has reviewed the referenced Free Product Recovery Report, 2<sup>nd</sup> Half of 2024 Report (AMR) submitted on January 23, 2025, by WSP USA on behalf of the Magellan Pipeline Company L.P. (Doc# 42278).

DNR acknowledges the recovery of 126 gallons of product between July and October 2024. Only 29 gallons of product was recovered between November and December 2024.

DNR approves the removal of Sump-10 from routine gauging and product recovery. Sump-10 will need to be monitored monthly maintaining a product level of 0.02 inches of product or less. Should product levels be observed above 0.02 inches it will likely need to be returned to routine gauging. Sump-9 will need to continue monthly gauging having not met the requirement of 12 consecutive months of 0.01 inches of product or less as described in Iowa code 567-135.7(11) *f*.
