Dear Mr. Fisher:

We have reviewed the Phase II environmental site assessment report on the above-mentioned property. We are pleased to learn that soil removal had been effected at the former diesel tank location where a release to soil was noted in a Phase I environmental site assessment. The report indicated soil removal occurred in an area measuring 10 ft. x 10 ft x 5 ft. Subsequent soil analysis for petroleum compounds did not detect any petroleum components above statewide standards. Groundwater sample data was not included in the report. An on-site well is reportedly located at approximately 155 feet east and 32 feet north of the former diesel tank location.

Based on the information provided to the department, no further action is necessary at this site. Please note the department does not consider Phase II environmental site assessments as comprehensive environmental investigations and, thus, may not provide a complete characterization of soil and groundwater conditions at the site. Therefore, the department reserves the right to require additional investigation or remediation if future information warrants such action.
