Lamdert Nnadi,

I apologize for taking so long to get back to you. I asked several people the questions that you asked, and didn't get a lot of help, so had to do some researching!

Well #1 and Well #2 are both down by the Bohlman building. We have not used these well for drinking water for several years, because of the nitrate level. I believe that the City has Well #2 on an emergency "standby" basis with the IDNR. We have a well #3 that is right along Highway 30, on the north edge of Dunlap. This is the well we use for drinking purposes.

Well #1 we believe is 83'6" deep.

Well #2 according to IDNR records is 85' deep

Yes, we know that there is a high number of nitrates in those wells. The storage tanks that are in the area belong to Dunlap Fertilizer. I believe I have seen in some old papers that at one time one of the wells had been leased to them for personal use.

If I can be of any other help, please let me know.
