- B. 00300 - PROPOSAL - Because of the increase in the estimated cost, the Proposal Guarantee amount and the Liquidated Damages amount have been increased to \$200,000.00 and \$1,000/day, respectively. The proposal has been updated to reflect these changes.
- B. 00500 - CONTRACT - Because of the increase in the estimated cost, the Proposal Guarantee amount and the Liquidated Damages amount have been increased to \$200,000.00 and \$1,000/day, respectively. The contract has been updated to reflect these changes.

**Plans:**

- A. Cast-in-place bridge abutments meeting the attached design are an approved substitution to bid item #34, *Precast Concrete Bridge Abutment System*. Concrete mix shall be C-4.
