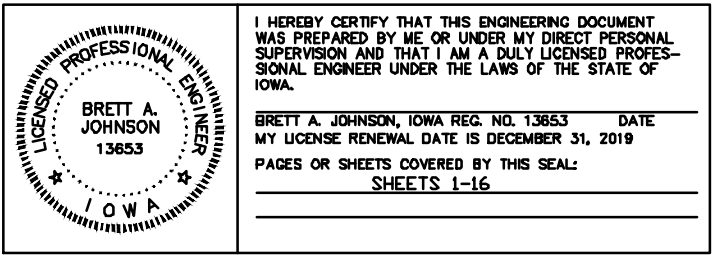
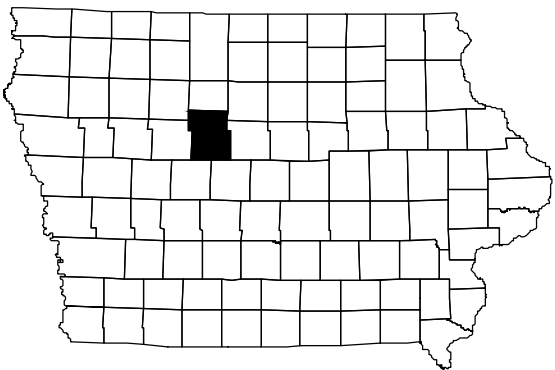

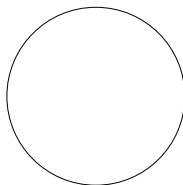
PROJECT DESCRIPTION

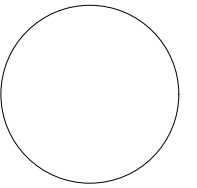


- SITE LOCATION.

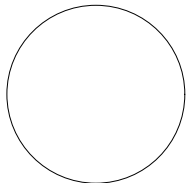

ALL CONSTRUCTION TESTING TO BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUDAS AND IS THE EXPENSE OF THE CONTRACTORS. 3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE EXISTING CONDITIONS PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION AND NOTIFY THE ABOVE MENTIONED CONTACTS OF ANY DISCREPANCIES. 4. 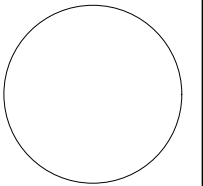

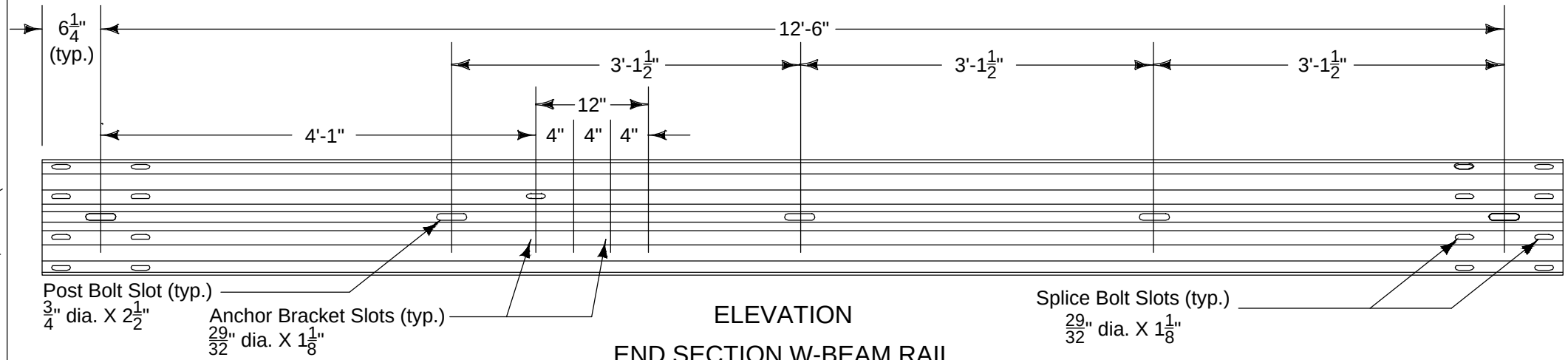
ELEVATION
