Re: Chamness Technology Eddyville Organics Recycling & Compost Facility Pad Update

Kurt –

As discussed during the conference call between yourself and Gary Chamness on April 2nd, the following update is provided regarding the efforts and intentions to continue removal of finished/ cured, unscreened compost off of the Compost Pad to facilitate windrowing.

Weather permitting, land/mine reclamation will continue by moving cured/finished compost off of the Compost Pad and initially onto the field to the east of the Compost Facility as well as immediately south of the Facility Maintenance Building/north of the East Storm Water Retention Lagoon (labelled Sites A & B respectively on the attached drawings). Additionally, cured/ finished, unscreened compost will be temporarily stockpiled on the crop field immediately west of the Compost Pad and, as necessary, along the southern edge of the crop field south of the Compost Facility (labeled Sites C & D respectively).

Commencing April 6th, land application of water from the three storm water retention lagoons in Eddyville will begin (again, weather permitting) in accordance with the facility's approved Wastewater Operating Permit to maintain the water levels in each lagoon at minimum levels.

As mentioned during the telephone call, a new Site Manager will be in place starting April 6th to direct/oversee daily operations and expedite the steps being taken to bring the Compost Pad back into operational compliance. Additional, follow-on personnel actions effecting the staffing of the Eddyville Facility are also expected to begin during the week.

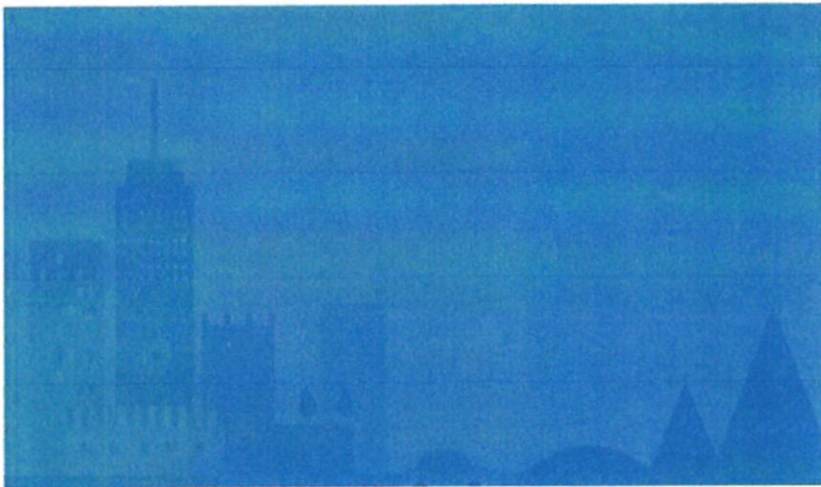

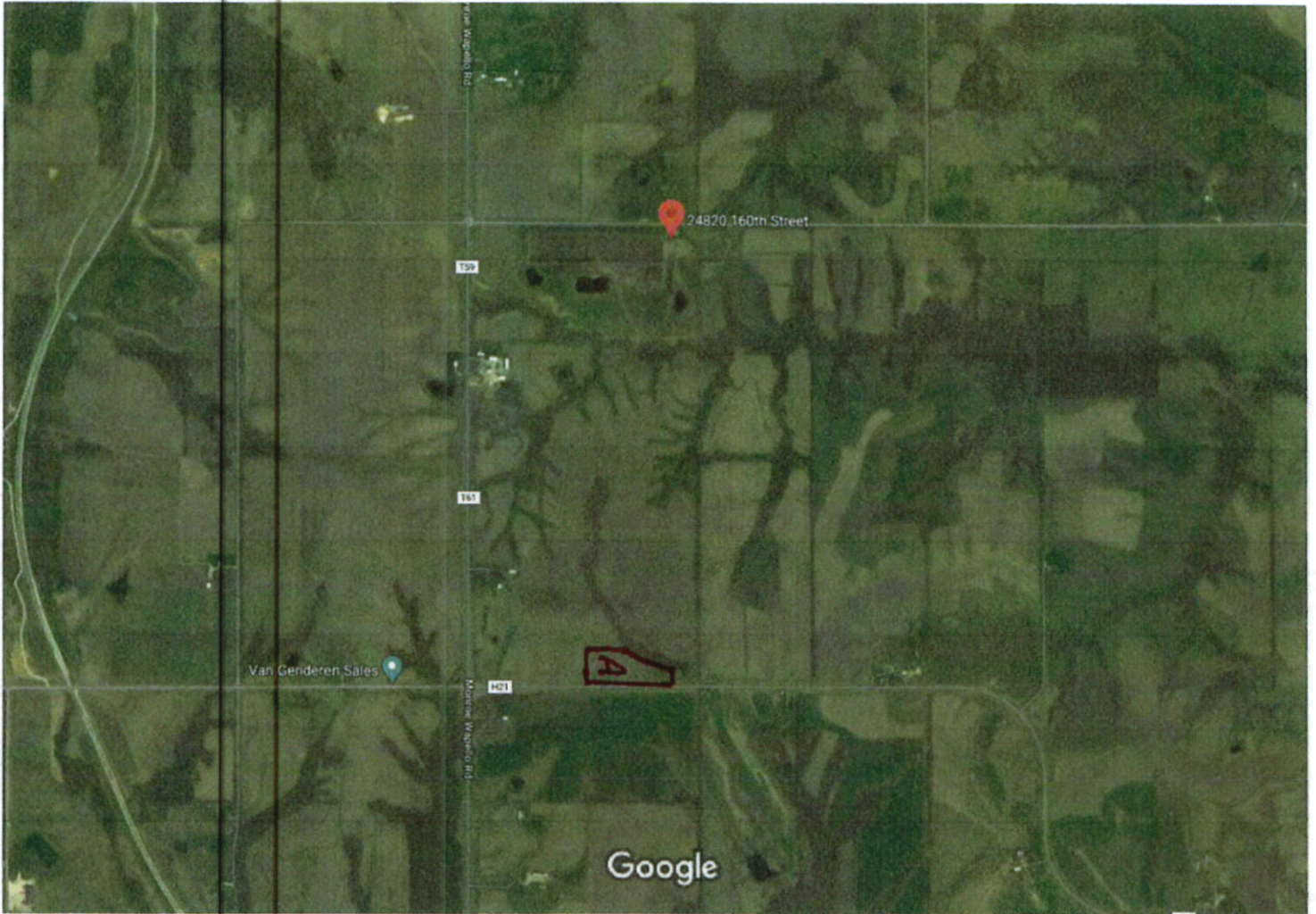

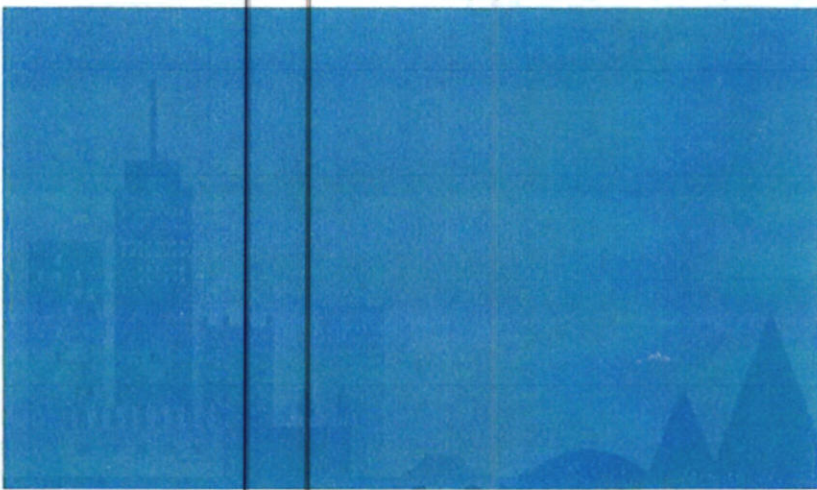
