Dear Mr. Simmons:

As we discussed on the telephone on October 21 2010, City of Ottumwa Water Pollution Control Facility (WPCF) would accept hauled wastewater from the Eddyville Ia., Chamness Technology compost facility, under certain conditions.

The wastewater would be removed from one or two holding ponds that collect wastewater from the compost operation and hauled probably by 6000-gallon tanker semi tractor-trailers. The discharge location would be at the WPCF designated dumpsite.

The following conditions would apply to this agreement to accept Chamness Technology wastewater from Lagoon holding ponds.

1. Chamness would need to receive verbal approval from the WPCF Superintendent, Supervisor or Pretreatment Coordinator prior to bringing any wastewater on a daily basis.
2. Chamness would agree to pay any fees associated with the acceptance of such wastewater.
3. The WPCF reserves the right to refuse the acceptance of any wastewater from Chamness Technology at any time.
4. A daily volume limit of 24,000 gallons is assigned. (4 – 6000 gal Semi Loads)
5. Chapter 31 of City of Ottumwa Code of Ordinances (Sewers and Sewage Disposal) applies to this agreement.
