**SUBJECT:** Old (Closed) Humboldt County Landfill, Permit No. 46-SDP-1-73P

On June 7, 2010 I visited the old Humboldt County Landfill to evaluate progress with two requirements listed in the previous inspection report dated November 6, 2008. The required actions were 1) repair the pond areas, and 2) monitor the swale on the east-facing slope for leachate. No one was present during my visit.

I found that the pond areas had been repaired and seeded. Vegetation was becoming established. Dave Minikis, MER Engineering, reported that the areas were repaired this spring.

I did not get a chance to look at the potential leachate seep area due to adverse weather. Mr. Minikis told me that he inspects the site at least three times annually, and would be on site later this month and would evaluate the leachate seep area. I will stop at the site later this year to follow-up as well.
