I believe this complaint was called in by an individual employed by Sivy Steel. He believed actions Sivy Steel are taking to dewater their foundry sand pit are wrong and wanted to report them. He says they are pumping water from a 30,000 gallon pit that contains contaminated foundry sand from their operations and the water is being released into the Mississippi River. The caller said they had been in trouble for doing this in the past.
