Dear Mr. Elmore:

Our office recently received a complaint alleging that hog manure originating from one of your buildings had been surface applied within the separation distance of a residence. I have not been unable to contact you to discuss this complaint and verify if the manure had originated from one of your buildings. Regardless, measurements I made between the residence and the application area were just under the 750 feet required. However, because it was difficult to determine the exact boundary of the application area, I could not document a violation of the manure application separation distance rules.

I have enclosed a table of the manure application separation distances for your future reference. Please note that in addition to the distance to a residence there are also distances to water sources and wells when surface applying manure. Also note the exemptions for small animal feeding operations etc.
