Administrative Consent Order No. 2010-AQ-52 was issued to Holcim (US), Inc. (Holcim) on November 30, 2010, for the purpose of addressing monitored violations of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for particulate matter with an aerodynamic diameter of less than or equal to 10 microns (PM-10) in Mason City, Iowa. As of March 1, 2010, Holcim's Mason City plant had ceased operation, and the purpose of Administrative Consent Order No. 2010-AQ-52 was to delineate Holcim's obligations during the period of plant shutdown. The order required that prior to the resumption of plant operations at any level, Holcim would work with DNR to update the order to reflect the resumption of plant operations.

Since the issuance of Administrative Consent Order No. 2010-AQ-52, at Holcim's request, Holcim's air quality construction permits and Title V operating permit have been rescinded, and Holcim has determined that the plant will not resume operations.

Therefore, Administrative Consent Order No. 2010-AQ-52 is hereby rescinded.
