Permit number 82-SDP-12-93 issued on March 3, 2020 for the Davenport Compost facility in Davenport IA is hereby amended by the following:

Special provision #1

- 1. The permit holder is authorized to accept and compost up to 23,750 29,000 tons of municipal wastewater treatment sludge annually combined with bulking agent [bulking agents such as untreated/uncontaminated construction & demolition (C & D) wood waste, yard waste and tire shreds] from generators within the following service area:
 - a. Sludge Davenport Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP services Davenport, Bettendorf, Panorama Park and Riverdale),
 - b. C & D wood waste Scott County Municipal Solid Waste Landfill, and;
 - c. Yard waste all cities and the unincorporated areas of Scott County.
