- 2. Recyclable materials, lead acid batteries, used oil, anti-freeze, scrap metal, yard waste, or other recyclable materials that have an end value, are collected by third party processor at no cost, or are sold for profit.

^{*}White goods are calculated by the number on hand at the time of the inspection (14) times \$10.00 each for a disposal cost. In this case it is \$140.00.

^{**}Used tires are calculated by the number on hand at the time of inspection (22) times \$2.00 disposal cost for each tire. In this case it is \$44.00.

^{***}Brown goods (electronics) are calculated at the estimated number of pounds delivered at \$0.08 (eight cents) per pound. In this case, an estimate of (32) units weighing approximately 14 pounds each (448 lbs) is used. In this case, the disposal cost is estimated at \$2.56.


