Enclosed is the renewed transfer station permit for the above-referenced facility. The permit is authorized from May 3, 2020 to May 3, 2023. The permit certificate must be posted at the facility and the permit provisions and approved engineering plans and specifications kept on file at the facility.

You will also notice some activities conducted at the transfer station that were included in previous permits are no longer included within this permit renewal. Activities that do not require a sanitary disposal project permit per Iowa Code and Iowa Administrative Code will not be addressed in this renewal. However, we encourage best management practices for all waste, recyclable and reusable materials.

Please note that the permit contains special provisions that may require a response or action by you, which if not properly complied with, may prompt enforcement action by the DNR. 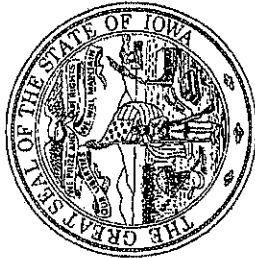


