Attached please find an updated Organizational Chart for Bell Salvage. One employee was removed. Everyone else listed remains the same.

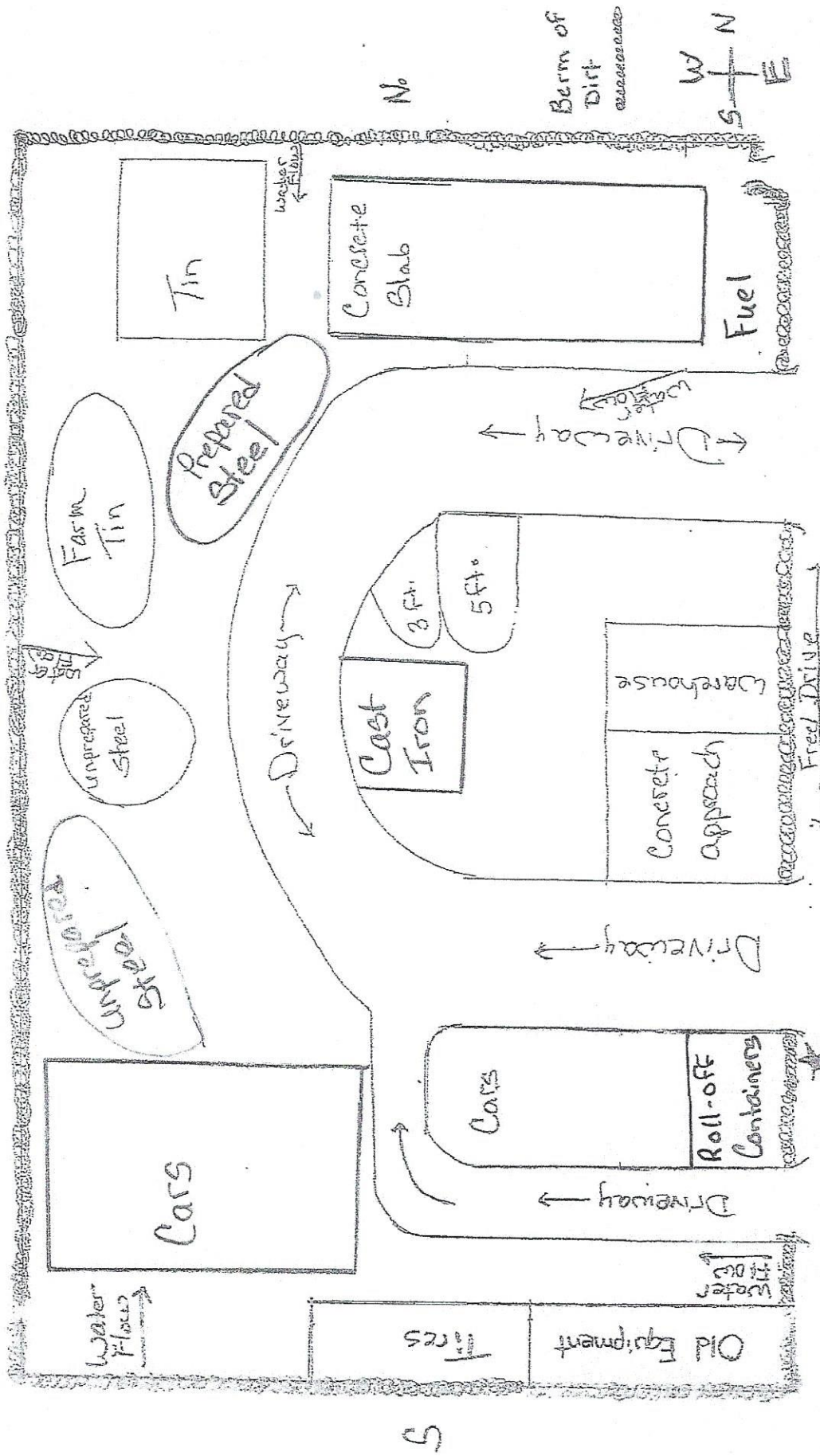
Everything else remains the same and all permits have been renewed.

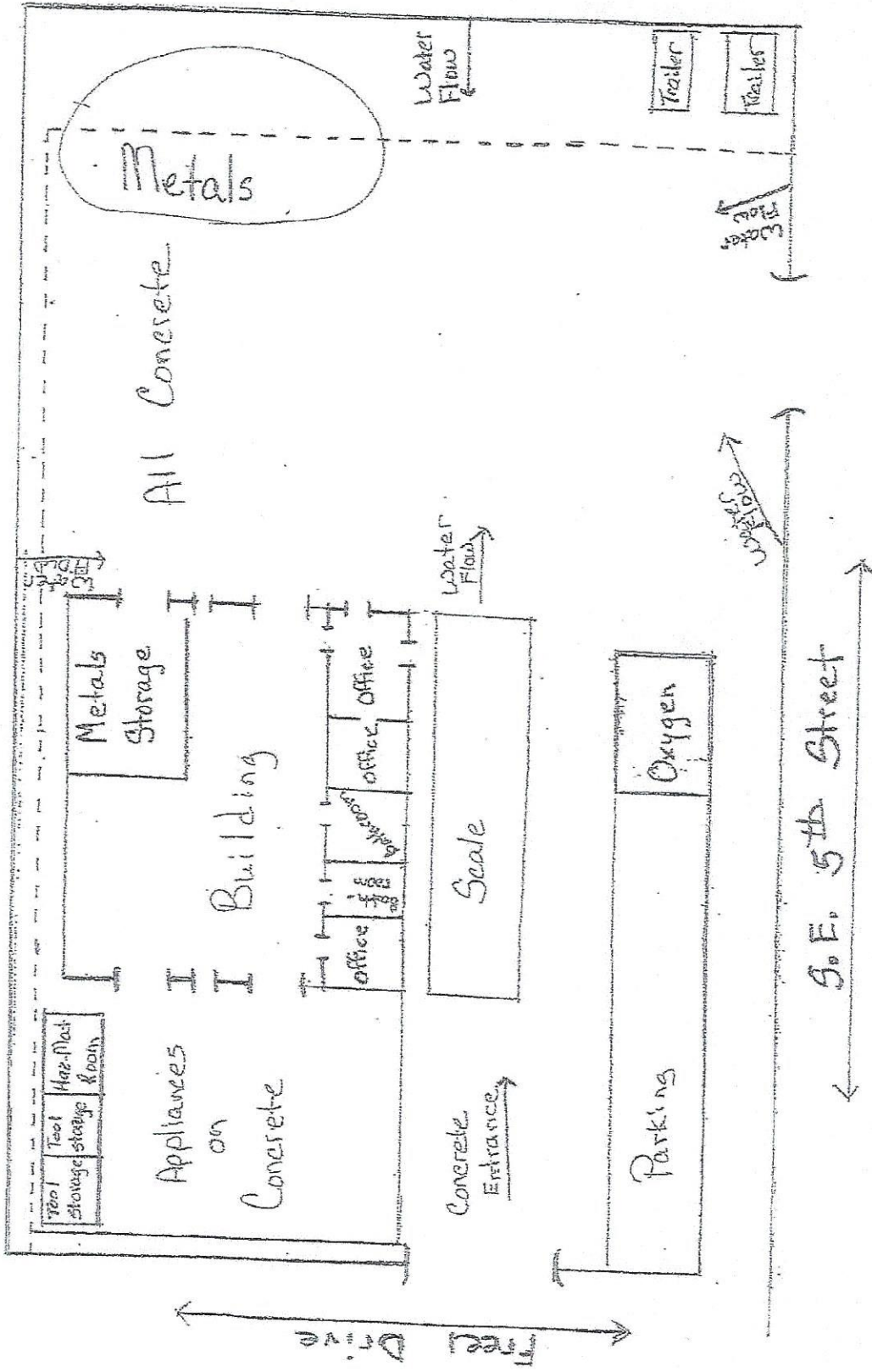
